# ADEQUATE SUPPLIES

Supporting healthy hygiene behaviors by providing adequate supplies, including trash bags, cleaning gloves, paper towels, and cleaning/disinfectant solution.




# SIGNS AND MESSAGE

- ▶ Hand washing Posters
- ▶ Plexiglass frames
- ▶ Messaging through google classroom
- ▶ Morning announcements
- ▶ Signs for water fountains (turn water fountains off)



# CLEANING AND DISINFECTION

- ▶ Increase cleaning for door handles, sinks and playgrounds
- ▶ Classroom & Specials cleaning protocol
- ▶ Bus cleaning protocol
- ▶ No shared items
- ▶ Posters and masks on bus
- ▶ More large trash bins
- ▶ Power washers/trailers




# SHARED OBJECTS

- ▶ Revised school supply list - Individual School Supplies
- ▶ Belongings separated
- ▶ Individual box/bag





# VENTILATION

- ▶ Increase filter changes
- ▶ Increase ventilation - open windows once a day, where possible
- ▶ Towable Manlift
- ▶ Upduct Review



# WATER SYSTEMS

- ▶ **Supply Water bottles during the midday**
- ▶ **Shutting down water fountains**
- ▶ **Students bring water bottle from home**



# MODIFIED LAYOUTS

- ▶ Outdoor canopies for eating and classrooms
- ▶ Space seating/desk at least 6 feet apart, when feasible
- ▶ Turn desks to face in the same direction
- ▶ Create distance between children on school buses





# PHYSICAL BARRIERS AND GUIDES

- ▶ Plexi-guards for secretary and additional areas
- ▶ Tape and Tiger decals for spacing




# COMMUNAL SPACES

- ▶ **Sinks and Urinals - Shut off the ones that are less than six feet**
- ▶ **Create bathroom cleaning charts**



# FOOD SERVICE

- ▶ Rolling Carts to provide food to classrooms
- ▶ Stickers/Wall clings for spacing in common areas
- ▶ Swipe Cards for the High School
- ▶ Preorder App
- ▶ Ice Chests
- ▶ Exploring possibility of free lunches for everyone
- ▶ Ice blankets
- ▶ Insulated food carriers



# PROTECTIONS FOR STAFF AND CHILDREN AT HIGH RISK FOR SEVERE ILLNESS FROM COVID-19

Will be addressed individually for people in these categories;



- ▶ 65 years or older
- ▶ Chronic Lung Disease or mod/severe Asthma
- ▶ Serious Heart Conditions
- ▶ Immunocompromised - Cancer Treatment Bone Marrow transplant, organ transplant, Immune Def. and HIV/AIDS, prolonged use of Corticosteroids or other other immunity decreasing medications
- ▶ Diabetes
- ▶ Severe Obesity (BMI greater than 40)
- ▶ Chronic Diseases undergoing dialysis
- ▶ Liver Disease

# PREPARING FOR WHEN SOMEONE GETS SICK

- ▶ **Medical 1st Aid Carts**
- ▶ **Separate waiting areas for ill and injured**
- ▶ **Curtains to isolate**
- ▶ **Infrared and oral thermometers for nurses**
- ▶ **Isolation gowns**
- ▶ **Handouts on when to stay home**
- ▶ **Emergency pickups**





# ISOLATE AND TRANSPORT THOSE WHO ARE SICK

- ▶ **Student or Staff with COVID like symptoms will be isolated until someone picks them up or EMS arrives.**
- ▶ **Positive COVID test will follow the guidance of Public Health Authority.**
- ▶ **Contact tracing begins with Nurse who notifies the Director.**
- ▶ **Director will notify public health.**
- ▶ **Nurse Contacts at-risk families.**
- ▶ **Director will notify Admin and Admin will enforce plan.**
- ▶ **PPE to be worn by nurse.**
- ▶ **staff will not transport.**

# CLEAN AND DISINFECT

- ▶ **Health Services Director will notify custodial supervisor**
- ▶ **PPE available at school site**
- ▶ **Isolation at each school site**
- ▶ **Isolation Cleanup after Exposure - 1 day**
- ▶ **Deep Clean**




